BUS

Save money and avoid the parking crunch! Our students, faculty, and staff ride the local bus service for free! Champaign-Urbana Mass Transit District (MTD) offers special "hopper" and Illini routes to get you around campus quickly and easily. All MTD buses are ADA accessible and equipped with lift and a bike rack.

MTD buses can get you to nearly every part of Urbana, Champaign, and Savoy for free with your i-card. Apps, such as STOPwatch, tell you how many minutes until your bus departs. Schedules, routes, and the latest MTD news are available at **mtd.org/** and apps are available on app stores (iOS and Android).

BIKE AT **ILLINOIS**

This campus is recognized as a Bicycle Friendly University and both Urbana and Champaign are Bicycle Friendly Communities! Flat topography and short commutes make



bicycling an excellent option for getting around town. Free, local area bike maps are available through the Office of the Dean of Students.

Bicyclists are welcome on buses. Every MTD bus is equipped with a bike rack on the front.

Veo (Bike Share) provides dockless bike sharing to the cities of Champaign and Urbana and the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign. Download the Veo app, register, and you could be pedaling in minutes. Visit **www. veoride.com**.

Bicycle repair stations are located throughout Champaign-Urbana, complete with tools and air pumps to help you maintain your bike. Go to **bike.illinois.edu/ maps/biking-map/** for more information.
